Poggio Anima, Belial '14 10
Sangiovese ♦ Tuscany, Italy
Bright and fresh, with flavors of red cherry and flinty red berries with a touch of sweet pipe tobacco.

Bodegas Bleda, Pino Doncel Cinco Mesas '14 13
Monastrell/Syrah/Petit Verdot ♦ Jumilla, Spain
A touch of spice and tobacco with a persistent sensation of sweetness.

La Tour De Gâtigne, Cabernet Sauvignon '14 10
Cabernet Sauvignon ♦ Cévennes, France
Sustainable farmed in the the Languedoc-Roussillon, this Cab displays intense spice aromas and well balanced, round tannins.

AA Badenhorst, The Curator '13 9
Shiraz/Cinsault ♦ Swartland, South Africa
Grown in small plots on four different farms, this medium-bodied red has svelte tannins and plenty of rustic dark plum and raspberry fruit.

Castillo Monjardin, Old Vines Garnacha '15 8
Garnacha/Cabernet Sauvignon ♦ Navarra, Spain
Hand-picked grapes from 70 year old vines make up this easy drinking red with aromas of berries and violets with a long silky texture

Nuiton Beaunoy, Bourgogne Pinot Noir '15 14
Pinot Noir ♦ Côte d'Or, France
A bouquet of small, red fruits and black berries lead into a lively and generous wine.

Weingut Neiss, Spätburgunder Trocken 'Blanc de Noir' '16 9
Spätburgunder ♦ Pfalz, Germany
Very brief skin contact extracts the slightest bit of color. This sustainable wine is fermented for three weeks in stainless steel and bottled early.

Bodega Garciarevalo, Tres Olmos '15 12
Verdejo ♦ Castilla, Spain
This classic Rueda Verdejo has a lifted, juicy mouthfeel and dry, pithy, citrusy flavors that fold in stony notes and hints of green herbs.

Fox Run, Semi-Dry Riesling '15 10
Riesling ♦ Finger Lakes, New York
A wonderfully balanced palate, with a soft yet zesty finish. The moderate sweetness adds a richness and complexity that makes this a truly wonderful wine.

Franck & Sylvain Godon, Le Petit Godon NV 10
Sauvignon Blanc ♦ Loire, France
A bold and fresh palate with flavors of quince and pear, with a zesty finish.

Kavaklidere, Çankaya '15 11
Narince/Emir/Sultana ♦ Central Anatolia, Turkey
Tropical fruits are built around a fresh fruitiness and a little minerality with a gentle, satisfying finish with just a touch of oak for added complexity.

Mother Rock Wines, 'Force Celeste' Chenin Blanc '16 13
Chenin Blanc ♦ Swartland, South Africa
Dry-farmed bush vines grown on decomposed granite, no enzymes, yeasts or acids were added to this unfiltered and unfiltered natural Chenin Blanc.

Treveri, Gewürztraminer NV 11
Gewürztraminer ♦ Wapato, Washington
Notes of lychee jelly, combined with rich tropical fruit, all-spice, nutmeg, and clove are balanced with an underlying acidity for a true expression of the varietal

Gemme Rubia, Frizzante Dolce NV 10
Lambrusco ♦ Dell Emilia IGT, Italy
Ruby red with gentle and persistent foam round out intense blueberry and cherry flavors.

Hoya de Cadenas, Cava Brut NV 9
Macabeo/Chardonnay ♦ Penedes, Spain
Classic Spanish bubbles aged on its lees imparting a rich, brioche quality.

Blackwater, Lazy Lucy '17 9
Cinsault/Grenache ♦ Swartland, South Africa
Exhibiting crisp minerality and light salinity, this rosé is juicy and quaffable but with enough acidity to pair well with foods.

Les Embruns, La Croix des Saintes Sable de Camargue NV 10
Carignan/Cinsault/Grenache ♦ Languedoc, France
Organically produced to bring out the best of the Camargue terroir; authentic, wild and bursting with character.

Tenute Rubino, Rosato '15 12
Negroamaro ♦ Brindisi, Italy
Fresh, soft and pleasant, this rosé has a long and persistent finish.
